







## Annual Review for the session 2023-24


A meeting of the Review Committee was held in the Office of the Principal on dated. 25-06-2024 for the Annual Review of the session 2023-24. Based on the feedback from various stakeholders, committee submitted the following suggestions for future plans and goals for coming year:

## Action Plan and Goals for the Session 2024-25

1. Number of interactive sessions in Mentor-Mentee platform must be increased so students may be benefited to its optimum.
2. A Visitor Register in the Office of the Principal must be maintained so that esteem Visitors may register their valuable suggestions that may help in the upliftment of the institution.
3. Research Innovation Lab must be made effectively operative so both students and teachers may be benefited and may enhance their research skills.
4. As noticed that student foot fall in the Library is far below the average as per the total strength of the institution. Teachers along with the Library staff will motivate the students and will device the mechanism so number of beneficiaries may be increased. Concept of Flip classes may be introduced.
5. As IQAC group organized 2 month Communication skill enhancement course free of cost in collaboration with Career and Placement Cell. A very positive feedback suggests that such skills enhancing course may be organized in more number so maximum students may be benefited.
6. Seminars/ guest lectures/ workshops must be conducted in more numbers as compared to present number so students may have the opportunity to learn more and enhance their skills and knowledge.
